- 3. This is a mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting and Prime Bidders are limited to those in attendance.
- 4. Bids Due at 11:00 a.m. local time on Thursday, September 21, 2017.
- 5. The Wage Rates for this project shall be as determined by the Delaware Department of Labor and Division of Industrial Affairs for Kent County. A certified copy has been included in the Project Manual, however, Contractors are responsible to contact the Delaware Department of Labor to receive verification of the most current Wage Rate Scale.
- 6. Only plan holders who received bid document sets from Tetra Tech, and that signed the Pre-Bid meeting sign-in sheet, will receive ADDENDA.

- 8. The following items were discussed in greater detail:
 - A. Contractors may copy the Bid Form; submit single original.
 - B. Contractors shall identify the time of construction in their Bid Form. It is the intent of the project to be substantially complete in two hundred fourty-five (245) days (from approximately starting on November 1, 2017) or June 1, 2018.
 - C. All discrepancies, questions or requests for clarifications or interpretations must be submitted to the Engineers office at least seven (7) days prior to bid due date (Thursday, September 14, 2017). The last Addendum will be issued on Monday, September 18, 2017.
 - D. Requests for Substitutions must be submitted to the Engineer's Office at least ten (10) days prior to the bid due date (Monday, September 11, 2017).
 - E. Contractor must list themselves as the Subcontractor for all work which they propose to accomplish.
 - F. Failure to list a Subcontractor Category could be grounds for a bid to be considered non-responsive.
 - G. A Bid Security, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the Base Bid is required. There are no Alternates.
 - H. Temporary heat or utilities should not be required on this project. Refer to the Phasing of Construction discussion.
 - I. Facility restrooms are available, they must be kept clean.
 - J. It was stated that DEARNG staff will not be working every other Monday. As a result every other Monday will be considered as a non-working day for the Contractors and DEARNG staff.
 - 1. Normal working hours are between 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday thru Friday. Working hours for Fridays before off-Mondays are from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.
 - 2. Additional hours must be arranged in advance.
 - 3. Day-Off Schedules for 2017 and 2018 have been attached to these Meeting Minutes.
 - K. All vehicles and tool boxes shall be locked at all times. The Contractor will be allowed to park in the back parking lot.
 - L. No dumping will be allowed on the project site. Trash, debris and waste must be removed from the building daily and from the site as required or directed. Dumpster location to be coordinated at the Pre-Construction Meeting.
 - M. The Project Front End Specifications requires a two (2) year Warranty and Guarantee Period after acceptance by the Owner.
 - N. Under the Project's Front End Specifications, the Performance and Labor & Material Payment Bonds shall be maintained in full force (warranty bond) for a period of two (2) years after the date of the Certificate for Final Payment.
 - O. Contractors are responsible for all permits.
 - P. No Addenda will be issued later than four (4) days prior to the date for receipt of Bids except an Addendum withdrawing the request for Bids or one which extends the time or changes the location for the opening of bids. The last addendum will be issued Monday, September 18, 2017.
 - Q. Each Bidder shall ascertain prior to submitting their Bid that they have received all Addenda issued, and shall acknowledge their receipt in the Bid in the appropriate space.
 - R. The Schedule of Values shall include a line item for the submission of the Project Closeout Documents. The value of this item shall be no less than 1% of the initial contract amount.
 - S. All utility shutdowns must be coordinated with DEARNG Maintenance.

- T. Contractor must fill out the Affidavit of Employee Drug Testing Program Form for their Company and all listed Subcontractors. Submit one (1) copy for each Contract and/or a Subcontractor.
- U. The DDC/BAS Controls will be part of an allowance directly with the Succesful Contractor under the Base Bid.
- 9. The drawings were reviewed.
 - A. Project will be accomplished in Phases over a 245 day period.
- 10. Job Site Requirements
 - A. Coordinate with DEARNG staff well in advance of any power interruptions.
 - B. Project will be accomplished in Phases over a 245 day period.
 - C. Contractors are required to remove and re-install the existing ceiling, and are responsible for any damages.
- 11. Proposed Phasing/sequencing was discussed.
 - A. The building will be partially occupied.
 - B. The successful Contractor shall submit a phasing/sequencing plan after award. The occupants will relocate accordingly.
 - C. The perimeter HVAC System (PTAC Units and Heating Piping) must remain in operation during the upcoming heating season.
 - D. Starting November 2017, Contractor shall install all refrigerant piping, ceiling equipment, outdoor condensing units and ventilation ductwork located above the ceilings, in the corridors and interior spaces up and into the perimeter offices.
 - E. Then starting approximately on May 1. 2018 the Contractors can shutdown the perimeter PTAC's and heating system and start the unit replacement and final piping.
- 12. A Site Review and walk-through of the work area was performed. The following items were discussed:
 - A. Dumpster will be allowed. It must be covered.
 - B. Parking will be permitted in the back lot.
 - C. Contractor will be required to move furniture.
 - D. Occupants shall be responsible to move Personal Item's, Computers, Books and Reference Material.
 - E. Contractors are responsible to protect all floors and carpeting.
 - F. Contractors are required to remove and re-install the existing ceiling, and are responsible for any damages.
