- 1.0 This addendum, Addendum No. 2, shall be made part of the Project Manual and Drawings dated July 2020 for the Bethany Beach Training Site Inverter System Replacement for the Delaware Army National Guard.
- 2.0 Sealed bids for DEARNG Contract No. 2019-07 – Bethany Beach Training Site Inverter System Replacement, will be received by the Delaware Army National Guard at the Security Officers desk in the Main Lobby of the Biden National Guard/Reserve Center, 1 Vavala Way, New Castle, Delaware, 19720 until **2:00 PM local time on August 12, 2020**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Multi-Purpose Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Replace Bid Form in project manual with the one attached to this Addendum #2. The “Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance” has been omitted as it is no longer required to be submitted with the contractor’s bid. This Bid Form shall be used with the contractor’s bid.
- 3.2 Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance:
Add “Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance” in its entirety. The Craft Training Compliance Affidavit must be submitted prior to contract execution. In addition to this Affidavit, all information pertaining to craft training for subcontractors must also be submitted prior to contract execution.

- 5.0 Questions/Clarifications
- 5.1 On the Bid Form, Page 7 “Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance”, what do we write on the “Contractor/Subcontractor Program Registration Number” line if we are exempt from this requirement based on the criteria listed on the form?

Answer: Effective August 7, 2020, the “Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance” for the Prime Bidder will not be required to be provided with the Bid Submission. This Affidavit has been removed from the Bid Form, which is reissued under this Addendum.

A new “Affidavit of Craft Training Compliance” is included in this Addendum. The Craft Training Compliance Affidavit must be submitted prior to contract execution. In addition to this Affidavit, all information pertaining to craft training for subcontractors must also be submitted prior to contract execution.
