GENERAL ITEMS:

1. All work associated with the removal, and re-construction of the curb shall be an alternate. Use attached revised bid form.
2. The project base bid shall be to repair/fix the cracks throughout the flight pad, and re-stripe the flight pad. Contractors shall repair/fix approximately 21,000 linear feet of cracks in the flight pad, and field verify crack locations. Provide documentation on a weekly basis to the extent of cracks completed.
 - a. All cracks 1/4" and larger shall be routed, filled with backer rods, primed, and filled with asphalt joint sealer. Refer to specification section 23 13 73 for additional information.
 - b. All cracks less than a 1/4" shall be filled with asphalt joint sealer. Refer to specification section 23 13 73 for additional information.
3. Contractors shall clean entire work area on a daily basis to keep the flight pad free of debris.
4. Flying could occur during construction. Contractor to stop work while flight operations are taking place, and adhere to direction provided from the Delaware Air National Guard.
5. For bidding purposes contractor shall assume the project shall be performed in 4 phases. Phases to be determined during the pre-construction meeting.
6. All work associated with this project shall be performed Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Monday. No work shall be performed on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday due to flying schedules.

QUESTIONS:

1. The unit cost is based per SF, does that mean we will have to keep track of the length and width of the cracks and divide the that by 144 square inches per square foot to determine the cost? Can the unit be LF?

RESPONSE: Contractors shall provide two unit prices on a linear foot cost basis for additional cracks over the base bid length for each size crack listed above. Use attached revised bid form.
