

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for the Cape Henlopen School District, 2019 Asbestos Abatement of the Rehoboth Elementary School, Bid and Little Buildings will be accepted **until 2:00 p.m., local time on Thursday, July 19, 2018 at the Cape Henlopen School District office, 1270 Kings Highway, Lewes, Delaware 19958.** Bids will be publicly opened, read, and recorded.

The work consists of the removal of asbestos-containing floor tiles and associated mastic, carpet glue and associated mastics, pipe coverings (insulation and fittings), HVAC dustwork mastic, vibration dampening cloth, ceiling tile and chalkboard glue dots, sink undercoatings, fire doors, asbestos heat shields, cement transite panels, valve, fittings and equipment gaskets, boilers and components, caulks and glazing, flashing tar and roofing. The work also requires the Contractor to provide break-in points through out the buildings to inspect within ceilings, walls and floors. Also, the work involves removal of pipe coverings and debris from pipe trenches.

A MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING will be held on Thursday, June 28, 2018 at 10:00 A.M., local time, starting at the Rehoboth Elementary School (Large Building), 500 Stockley Drive, Rehoboth Beach, Delaware. **ATTENDANCE AT THE PRE-BID MEETING IS A MANDATORY PREREQUISITE FOR SUBMITTING A BID ON THIS PROJECT.** Each prospective bidder must be represented by a full-time employee of that company. Attendees may not represent more than one company.

The bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids.

A bid bond is required. A performance bond and payment bond is required if the based bid is greater-than \$ 50,000.00.

The Cape Henlopen School District may extend the time and place for the opening of bids from that described in the advertisement on not less than two (2) calendar days' notice, by certified delivery, facsimile machine, or other electronic means to those bidders who obtained copies of the bidding documents.
