Questions	Answers
1. We do not have a maximum number of students we can serve, but our pricing structure does vary according to grade level and number of students served. Would you be able to provide a threshold of students who may be part of this program? We'd like to accommodate any tiered pricing if possible.	It is difficult to predict how many students will need homebound within a given school year however using this year's numbers we can estimate the following: 150+ secondary students (grades 6-12) and 50+ elementary students (grades K-5). <i>NOTE: Our current homebound contracts do not have tiered pricing and we compensate on a flat rate per hour.</i>
2. Can completed assignments and materials be provided virtually for online providers?	Yes, if assignments and materials were provided electronically then they can be returned electronically unless the instructor has another preference.
3. Just to confirm – preference to Christina School District teachers applies only when the vendor has hired that instructor and should be above priority for any other Delaware-certified teacher assignment?	Yes, that is the correct interpretation.
