

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for Christina School District's "Shue-Medill Middle School Domestic Hot Water Heater Replacement" will be received by the Christina School District, at the Eden Support Center, 925 Bear Corbitt Road, First Floor Plans Room, Bear, Delaware 19701 until 2:00 pm local time on April 20th 2016, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves:

- a. Removal of existing domestic hot water boiler, related pumps, piping, breeching, boiler brick base and related controls.
- b. Installing new gas fired high efficiency hot water heater including storage tank, pumps, piping, venting and all related ancillaries.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Tuesday April 5th at 9:00 am at Shue-Medill School, 1500 Capital Trail Rd., Newark, DE 19713 at the school's Main Entrance, for the purpose of reviewing the project, establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. **ATTENDANCE OF THIS MEETING IS A PREREQUISITE FOR BIDDING ON THIS CONTRACT.**
