<p>1. Is the district interested in a proposal that would only offer school-based (at a vendor's school) twilight services as an alternative to visiting students at home or a public place? This scenario would exclude students on homebound for illness or injury, and would most likely require the district to award the RFP to at least one other vendor to ensure service delivery to injured or ill students.</p>	<p>The district is not interested in a proposal that would only offer school-based (at vendor's school) twilight services as an alternative to visiting students at home or a public place. The district does not provide transportation for homebound students.</p>
<p>2. Upon further review of the scope of work, the program as described utilizes teacher assignments and materials from the student's assigned school. Please confirm that the district is seeking personnel only to support the district's existing Homebound program.</p>	<p>The district is seeking personnel to support the existing homebound program including administration of National, State and district student assessments in addition to utilizing teacher assignments and materials from the student's assigned school.</p>
<p>3. Page 2, Bullet 2 states, "Provide assistance to students utilizing a web-based educational curriculum as assigned." Is the district seeking a homebound option which includes digital curriculum? If not, what digital curriculum does the district currently utilize at each level (K-5, 6-12)?</p>	<p>The district is not seeking a web-based educational curriculum specifically for homebound instruction. The intent is to have homebound instruction for students assigned to the current web-based educational curriculum. The district currently uses Edgenuity for 6-12.</p>

4. How many students does the district serve in Homebound at K-5 and at 6-12?	Approximately 50 students K-5 Approximately 100 students 6-12
5. Will Christina School District consider a response for grades 6-12 only with virtual instructional services?	No. The Christina School District will not have a virtual instructional program exclusive to homebound students in grades 6-12.
6. The Scope of Services states you are looking for assistance to students utilizing a web-based educational curriculum program as assigned. May we supply the curriculum or do you already have curriculum you would like assistance with? If so what is the name of the curriculum please.	The Christina School District currently uses the Edgenuity web-based educational curriculum program.
7. The Scope of Services states we need a designated person to pick up materials necessary for instruction and return all completed assignments to the designated pick up/drop off area at the school. Can this be done virtually?	Only assignments/materials that are provided virtually can be returned virtually. Not all assignments and materials necessary for homebound instruction are provided electronically.
