


Delaware Extrapolations (cont'd)

>> What if strategies were targeted at reducing the rate of older youth in care?


Rate of Children In Care, by Age (per 1000)

In Delaware, the rate of children in care under age 18 is 3.4 per 1000, lower than the national rate of 5.2.




Scenario 4:

What if the rate of 13-17 year olds in care were reduced to the national average rate for 13-17 year olds (5.2)?



Scenario 5:

What if the rate of 13-17 year olds in care were reduced to the state rate for all children under 18?
