Issue:

On page 9 and page 12 the RFP indicates that in order for an agency to qualify to bid to provide IRT services the agency must already be licensed in the State of Delaware as a Child Placing Agency and have an office location in Delaware. This is not the case to qualify to submit a proposal. State of Delaware licensure as a Child Placing Agency is required to provide services in Delaware if awarded a contract via this RFP.

Resolution:

Strike from the RFP any indication or requirement that in order for an agency to be qualified to bid to provider IRT services it must demonstrate current licensure by the State of Delaware as a Child Placing Agency and/or have an existing office location in Delaware.

It is not a requirement that a bidding agency be licensed in the State of Delaware as a Child Placing Agency or have an established office location in Delaware in order to submit a proposal. However; a bidding agency should indicate if either are true and submit a copy of its current license if licensed in the State of Delaware as a Child Placing Agency.

Agencies awarded a contract to provide IRT services are required to be licensed by the State of Delaware as a Child Placing Agency in order to provide IRT services.
