ADDENDUM #13 - April 22, 2014

The Notice of Intent to award as published in Addendum #12 dated February 3, 2014 is hereby withdrawn to address a bid protest. The Delaware Department of Correction is providing additional information identified through the bid protest process that would have allowed Qualified Bidders (as defined below) to submit the most competitive and responsive proposals. The Bureau of Correctional Healthcare Services is reopening the Request for Proposal (RFP) DOC1427-PHARM, Correctional Health Care Pharmaceutical Services solely for those qualified parties who timely submitted Mandatory Letters of Intent to Bid and who had representatives present at the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting (the "Qualified Bidders").

All terms of the initial RFP, as amended and supplemented by Addendums #1 through #12, remain the same except as amended hereby. This Addendum #13 includes a new timeline for certain critical events and contains additional information and disclosures to assist Qualified Bidders in submitting proposals.
