How are those words defined? | These words are defined as materials necessary to perform the service you are offering to provide the Department if hired. For example: If the Department hires you to provide Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) we would expect you have the equipment necessary to perform this services (i.e. cones, drums, safety vest, etc.) and not expect to charge the Department for these items. |
| 2 | Can you provide the link or location for the DELDOT 2014 Fiscal Year engineering pay scales? | We do not publish engineering pay scales; therefore, that information is not available. |
