1	Is there an anticipated size inspection staff they are looking for with each agreement? We have several CCR local, but wanted to make sure we had an appropriate amount of staff to include in the RFP.	No numerical requirements for the amount of CCR’s a consultant would need. However, we are focused on making sure that selected firms can potentially handle all the active projects throughout the state. Our rough estimate is that there could be upwards of 20 – 25 active projects throughout the state at any given time.
