Q #	Question	Answer
10	Are plans for the project available for review?	Not at this time.
9	Please confirm that the intent is to include copies of certifications and/or one page resumes under the References section, after the one page reference letters.	Confirmed. Certifications and/or one page resumes are to be placed in the Reference section of your submission.
8	Is the one page resume required to be in SF 255 or SF 330 format?	<i>Either</i> a Form SF330 <i>OR</i> SF254 and SF245 are required. The resume format should follow the form you submit.
7	Are copies of certifications and/or resumes required for support staff listed in the organization chart that are not included as key staff in Section D?	No, information is required for key staff only.
6	Page 8, Section E - Bullet (2) requires copies of official NICET certifications or college diplomas for all personnel expected to be available for this project, or a one page resume. Since key staff resumes are already provided in Section D, do we need to include another copy of the resume in Section E if the key staff does not have NICET certification?	An additional resume is not necessary. Please address this by referencing in Section E that no NICET certification has been awarded for this individual, and to see the resume located in Section D. This should be done individually for all personnel that do not have NICET certification.
5	Are SF 254 Forms (or SF 330 Part II Forms) required for each proposed subconsultant?	Yes, these forms are required in your Expression of Interest.
4	The RFP for <i>Construction Inspection Services US301, Maryland State Line to SRI</i> gives a listing of firms who are not eligible to participate because of previous work; does that ineligibility extend to the subs of those firms who worked with those Primes?	No, those subconsultants are eligible for this RFQ.
3	As Area 9 - Land Surveying is not a primary required services, can the requirement for pre-registration in the area of Land Surveying be satisfied by a subconsultant rather than the Prime Consultant?	Pre-registration in Land Surveying is no longer a requirement and has been removed from the RFQ.
2	May a firm proposing as a prime also be included as a subconsultant on a separate team for this pursuit?	Yes, this is allowed.
1	It appears that two RFQs for this Agreement were posted on the GSS website. Which one should we use?	The RFQ currently posted the GSS website.
