26	<p><i>Page 13 5th bullet:</i> Will DeIDOT please provide historical data on how often the vendor has provided expert testimony in 2012?</p>	<p>Court hearings for contested citations are held on the second Thursday and Friday of every month. There is one court date per month for Kent County, Sussex County, and New Castle County. On average, New Castle County will have 10-15 cases on the docket, Kent County/Dover will have 5-10 cases, and Sussex County will have approx. 5 cases on the docket per month. A knowledgeable vendor representative is required to be present for each of these cases. The vendor's representative will provide testimony regarding how the red light camera system operates in order to generate a citation. The vendor representative will also provide testimony which outlines the quality controls in place to ensure data integrity and system performance.</p>
