1	<p>a.) I was wanting to know about the Certifications Part of the Proposal. If you have a category 3 pesticide applicators license, and are already a member of the DNLA, do you still need a Certified Nursery Professional Certificate? If yes, is another state's an equivalent, or what would be an equivalent?</p> <p>b.) Do you need to have more than the Pesticide applicators license present with one member on both crews, since it says either singly, combinations, then both must be present?</p>	<p>a.) Yes, a Certified Nursery Professional accreditation from the Delaware Nursery and Landscape Association(DNLA) or equivalent is required to be considered for this contract. Yes, similar accreditation from another state is considered to be an equivalent to a DNLA Certified Nursery Professional. Most states refer to the individual as either a certified or accredited nurseryman or certified nursery professional(CNP) or certified nursery landscape professionals(CNLP).</p> <p>b.) Yes, each crew must contain at least one member that is a State of Delaware Certified Applicator in Category 3 as well as a member that possess' accreditation equivalent to a DNLA Certified Nursery Professional as described in question (1) above. For example, one crew member could possess both certifications or it's also acceptable for one crew member to possess a State of Delaware Certified Applicator in Category 3 and another crew member to possess' the accreditation equivalent to a DNLA Certified Nursery Professional and still meet the requirements.</p>
