c.	Brush Control Line Item- when selecting herbicides for Brush Control, is browning of the foliage a concern to DelDOT?	Brownout is a minor concern, but can be controlled by herbicide selection and timing of application. DelDOT will forward brush treatment locations in a timely manner so that the contractor will be able to apply at the most strategic time to minimize any brownout.
b.	What does the Initial Expense cover on attachment E (pricing page)?	Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, August 2016. SECTION 763 INITIAL EXPENSE / DE-MOBILIZATION: 763.01 Description. Perform all operations necessary for the assembling and setting up of the Project, including the initial movement of personnel and Equipment to the Project site, the establishment of the Contractor's offices, shops, plants, storage areas, and sanitary facilities, any other activities required by the Contract Documents and by law or regulation, and all other Work and operations that must be performed prior to beginning compensable Items of Work on the Project. Obtain the required insurance and bonds, and all other Items required for the start of Work. Perform all operations necessary for the final cleanup of the jobsite, for demobilization of all personnel and Equipment, and for all paperwork necessary to close out the Project, including, but not limited to, obtaining releases from Subcontractors.
a.	Are all personnel required to have the State of Delaware Commercial Pesticide Applicator's License? It is our understanding that other employees can apply pesticides under a license holder's supervision.	All applicator personnel, including vehicle operator must be certified in accordance with the specification and Delaware Department of Agriculture regulations. One license holder with other employees will not qualify.
