Q #	Question	Answer
3	For the noxious weed control bid; In attachment 1, What number goes in the unit price number row, the price per acre or the price for 200 acres?	Unit price is considered to be the price for a single unit of measure. In this instance, unit price is the price per acre.
2	Is there any indication of site locations so travel time from one area to another can be calculated?	The site locations can vary from year to year so travel time cannot be calculated accurately. The Canada Thistle treatment locations are usually limited to Kent & New Castle Counties and the Phragmites treatment locations can be statewide, with the majority being concentrated in the coastal areas.
1	What percentage of the work for the noxious weed control RFP is going to be done from the truck in a broadcast application, versus an applicator making a hand application?	Most, if not all of the herbicide applications for this RFP will require spot applications to localized populations of noxious and invasive weeds. Broadcast applications over large acreages will be minimal under this RFP.
