3	<p>Video Pipe Inspection scope clarification, is it DelDOT's intention to have our staff</p> <p>a. Witness and document pipe inspections?</p> <p>b. Review completed inspections?</p> <p>c. Recommend repairs of noted deficiencies?</p>	<p>a. No, the video pipe inspection companies will be responsible for the work and will be required to submit to the consultant firm for review prior to submitting to DelDOT. Construction projects will have inspection staff on site to witness any video pipe inspections. Consultants will need to make sure they coordinate with the construction inspection staff.</p> <p>b. Yes, the consultant firms will need to make sure that the report being submitted is complete.</p> <p>c. Depending on the task. If they are construction contracts the contractor is required to submit the repair methods to the Department for review and approval. The consultants will only need to note the deficiency. If it is an existing pipe then the Department may ask the consultant to recommend a repair for the noted deficiency.</p>
