APPROACHES WILL BE RECONSTRUCTED AND GUARDRAIL WILL BE INSTALLED AS REQUIRED. SCOUR COUNTERMEASURES WILL BE PLACED IN THE STREAM TO PROTECT THE STRUCTURE.
