### **Substitution Evaluation Results (alphabetical order by company):**

1. Beynon requested approval of a substitution for the "Basis of Design" product identified in specification section 32 18 23.33 Synthetic Running Track Surfacing. The submitted request identified Beynon Sports BSS 1000 Full Pour Dual Durometer Light Encapsulated as an equal product. After careful review of the required and submitted documentation, it has been determined that the product meets or exceeds the product specifications indicated and is approved for basis of bid submission. Please note, this approval does not constitute approval of the contract mandated shop drawing and submittal process during which product will be further evaluated for compliance with project specifications.
2. California Sports Surfaces requested approval of a substitution for the "Basis of Design" product identified in specification section 32 18 23.33 Synthetic Running Track Surfacing. The submitted request identified CSS Plexitrac Accelerator as an equal product. After careful review of the required and submitted documentation, it has been determined that the product does not meet or exceed the product specifications indicated.
3. Hellas Construction, Inc. requested approval of a substitution for the "Basis of Design" product identified in specification section 32 18 23.33 Synthetic Running Track Surfacing. The submitted request identified epIQtracks Q3000 as an equal product. After careful review of the required and submitted documentation, it has been determined that the product meets or exceeds the product specifications indicated and is approved for basis of

bid submission. Please note, this approval does not constitute approval of the contract mandated shop drawing and submittal process during which product will be further evaluated for compliance with project specifications.

4. Hellas Construction, Inc. requested approval of a substitution for the "Basis of Design" product identified in specification section 32 18 23.29 Synthetic Field Sport Surfacing. The submitted request identified MatrixTurf Fusion<sup>H</sup>XP<sup>2</sup> as an equal product. After careful review of the required and submitted documentation, it has been determined that the product does not meet or exceed the product specifications indicated.
5. Shaw Sports Turf requested approval of a substitution for the "Basis of Design" product identified in specification section 32 18 23.29 Synthetic Field Sport Surfacing. The submitted request identified Shaw "Spikezone Pro" as an equal product. After careful review of the required and submitted documentation, it has been determined that the product does not meet or exceed the product specifications indicated.

#### **Questions and Answers:**

1. **Question:** Addendum refers to "clean" SBR rubber infill. Is first generation new SBR to be used or can washed, recycled SBR be used?  
**Answer:** The December 2016 Federal Research Action Plan on Recycled Tire Crumb Used on Playing Fields and Playgrounds, as published by the EPA, indicates "Given the relative paucity of investigations on worker-associated risks and activity related studies, there remains uncertainty in potential risks associated with the use of tire crumb rubber at synthetic turf fields and playgrounds." Accordingly, recycled infill, meeting all requirements of the specifications, will be considered during submittal review. Approval will be contingent that the supplier can provide details on the complete chain of custody of material; satisfactorily documenting that the supplied material used for infill has never been used for manufacturing tires. <https://www.epa.gov/sites/production/files/2016->

2. **Question:** Should contract A only consider schedule for turf removal and install? or is track to be part of schedule? Substantial completion for both contracts is 7/15?  
**Answer:** Each bid shall be submitted with a schedule, as prescribed. Substantial completion for both contracts is 7/15 in order to accommodate University activities. Both contractors shall be responsible for coordination with concurrent contract(s) being executed.
3. **Question:** Could you please confirm the University is tax exempt.  
**Answer:** Delaware State University is recognized by the IRS as a tax-exempt organization and is an agency of the State of Delaware.
4. **Question:** Will the University consider the use of previously used turf infill?  
**Answer:** Existing infill in the turf to be removed shall not be used in the new turf. The December 2016 Federal Research Action Plan on Recycled Tire Crumb Used on Playing Fields and Playgrounds, as published by the EPA, indicates “Given the relative paucity of investigations on worker-associated risks and activity related studies, there remains uncertainty in potential risks associated with the use of tire crumb rubber at synthetic turf fields and playgrounds.” Accordingly, recycled infill, meeting all requirements of the specifications, will be considered during submittal review. Approval will be contingent that the supplier can provide details on the complete chain of custody of material; satisfactorily documenting that the supplied material used for infill has never been used for manufacturing tires. 5. **Question:** Unit Price B1 refers to Mix Asphalt (CUYD). The Unit price description in the specifications refer to “mill” asphalt. Please advise the correct means and methods of the unit price.  
**Answer:** Refer to revised Specifications.
6. **Question:** Should Unit Price B1 be measured in tons instead of CUYD?  
**Answer:** Refer to revised Specifications.
7. **Question:** Is alternate B5 to be used for the 2” overlay of WMA for the entire track surface if needed?  
**Answer:** If a large quantity of WMA is needed to execute the project, the University will negotiate terms of a contract change in accordance with the terms of the contract.

8. **Question:** Can export materials such as millings, topsoil and/or fill dirt be disposed of onsite?  
**Answer:** The contractor shall be responsible for disposal of all waste material in accordance with applicable local, state, and federal codes.
9. **Question:** Is tack coat to be included in unit price B5? If so what is method of measurement?  
**Answer:** Tack coat of surface shall be assumed incidental to WMA pricing.
10. **Question:** Are there existing core samples of the asphalt base available for review?  
**Answer:** As the track is still in place, there are no existing core samples of the existing asphalt sub-base available.
11. **Question:** What are the means and methods to repair the asphalt substrate for planarity and slope once the existing synthetic surface is removed?  
**Answer:** Means and methods are the responsibility of the contractor. Refer to bid documents.
12. **Question:** Would a 13mm IAAF Certified full pour track surface be considered as a possible add/alternate?  
**Answer:** Only products submitted prior to the deadline were evaluated and considered.
13. **Question:** Please confirm the track surface is to be red.  
**Answer:** The intent of the University is to select a color from the manufacturer's standard color range.
14. **Question:** Is there a preferred staging area?  
**Answer:** Referred to enclosed "Staging Concept Plan" with recommended staging areas and construction vehicle access.
15. **Question:** If a bidder is bidding on both packages A & B, should they submit two schedules?  
**Answer:** All bids shall be accompanied with a schedule. If submitting on both package A & B, it will be required that bidders conform to the requirements of the submittal and include a schedule for each. Schedules may incorporate vendors approach at coordination with concurrent contracts.
