

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS: Sealed bids for the DTCC Powerplant Education Facility be received by Delaware Technical Community College, Owens Campus, Georgetown, Delaware, in the Student Services Building #21205, 18800 Seashore Highway, Georgetown, Delaware 19947, c/o Bob Hearn, Business Manager, on Thursday, December 20, 2012 at 3:00 pm local time, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Project involves the following: The construction of a new 1-story 9,600 square foot education facility and associated site improvements.
