Question 2:

For the Front Deck Riding Mowers – you specify a “Weather Guard Tool Box” but I have gone to a local Weather Guard Rep. and they said Weather Guard has no aluminum toolbox that small. Do you have an item number that I could give them? If not, are you looking for a just a basic metal toolbox 16” x 6” x 6”?

Response to Question 2:

The box is as stated or an approved equal. It does need to be all aluminum. Also need to be as close to the size as possible.

Question 1:

For the Front Deck Riding Mowers – you specify “a four (4) post roll-over protection with a metal canopy to withstand the weight of the machine.” Our units have a fully integrated ROPS that would bare the weight of the machine for increases operator safety. They do not offer a metal canopy but one made out of composite plastic that they use on their Utility Tractors for strength. Is this acceptable?

Response to Question 1:

The plastic or poly type canopy is acceptable as long as the posts are metal.
