A. In the slide deck from the webinar, July 18, 2013, on slide # 9, it stated “Vendors may submit a proposal for any or all of the categories listed in section 2.1 of the RFP’s, but may not submit for less than one entire category. Vendors must clearly identify in their proposal the category or categories, the section number(s) of the RFP and State for which they are proposing”; this information was incorrect.

Per the RFP in section 5.2 *Data Communications Services – Requirements* it says, “Offerors may respond to any of the sections where they have substantive product offerings that address the scope detailed in each Section from 5.2.1-5.3.0. All Offerors must include a response to section 5.31 services that addresses products proposed in 5.2.1-5.3.0.” A full and complete offering in any one category is not required.

B. In the slide deck from the webinar, July 18, 2013, on slide #17, it stated that “proposals must be submitted by August 30, 2013 at 11:00 am MST.” That should be August 30, 2013 at 11:00 am *MDT*.
