A7	Phase 5 is a term that refers to a training prop that the Delaware State Fire School (DSFS) currently uses. This prop provides extreme fire and smoke behavior for students to train in. Due to the extreme temperatures of this prop, the term "Phase 5" was given to the specific gear specification to differentiate the PPE requirement for those certified instructors.
