The Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health (DSAMH) is seeking to contract with one or more individual(s) to serve as a Training and Technical Assistance Coordinator for a Strategic Prevention Framework – State Incentive Grant (SPF-SIG) that is funded by a five year federal grant. The Project Coordinator will develop and manage SPF SIG training/technical assistance activities statewide.

Applicants must have strong interpersonal, analytical, organizational, planning and verbal/written communication skills are required. Degree in Public Health, Public Policy, Community Development, Social Worked (macro) Education, or Human Services is preferred. Bilingual capabilities are desirable. Personal mode of transportation required. Travel is frequent (weekdays, evenings, or weekends as required).

Resumes must be sent under cover of a brief letter of interest specifying hours of availability and proposed hourly rate. Both the letter of interest and the outer mailing envelope must reference RFP HSS-11-058. Any submission without the required information will not be reviewed. Applications will be accepted only from individual applicants.

Determination of qualified applicants will be based on a review of credentials (40%) and experience (60%). Selection of applicant(s) will be made by the Director of Community Mental Health and Addiction Services following interview of one or more qualified applicants. Actual service location, hours and rate of compensation is dependent on successful contract negotiation.
