| 4. Is the mode of delivery optional; managing the contracts?  | It will be face to face for the most part, but we are open to alternatives   |
| 5. What are some of the challenges...with providers?  | Finding locations is a challenge and getting the providers to attend the trainings.  |
| 6. Is there any type of evaluation with the training?   | Not at this time.  |
