1. Do you have meal volumes associated with the Home Delivered Meals portion of this RFP?

The following are the projected 2013 meal volumes:Title III Home Delivered609,000 mealsSSBG Home Delivered16,000 meals

2. Are there in person assessments that are needed to be done by us the provider?

There are rural and remote areas but we do not have any current clients that we would consider unreachable.

5. Would you consider awarding Home Delivered Meals to more than one vendor and allowing clients to have choice of provider, similar to the waiver program allows for?

Yes

6. Can meals arrive fresh and cold to the house as opposed to hot and prepared?

Yes, but whenever possible a hot, ready to eat home delivered meal is preferred.

7. Is this RFP for frozen meals that can be used for Home Delivered Meals and Congregate?

Frozen meals are only an option for home delivered meals.

8. Are the Home Delivered Meals and Congregate Meals bundled under one service provider?

No, the services are not bundled. Bids may be made for one service or both.

9. Clarify how many references are needed?
