Q1. Is there any special consideration if the person is a veteran? Are they restricted because they are veterans?

There are no special considerations for veterans, but all PATH intake forms must include the question of veteran status.

Q2. Because all homeless clients must be entered into the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS), called Community Management Information System in Delaware, there is a licensure fee for entering this information. Does the licensure cost become a responsibility of the vendor?

It is the responsibility of the provider to pay the licensing fee.

Q3. Will funding for HMIS technical assistance be provided to the successful vendor

The HMIS Licensing fee comes with Technical Assistance and training from the local HMIS administrator

Q4. If the bidder is required to provide 25% match indicated between the federal funds and the budget of \$400,000.00, is the state providing it? If not, is it cash match or can it be in-kind?

The State includes the match as part of the contract
