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**AMENDMENT # 2
TO THE CONTRACT
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES
DELAWARE HEALTH CARE COMMISSION
AND
MEDALLIES, INC.**

This second Amendment to the Contract dated November 9, 2016, is made and entered into between the State of Delaware, Department of Health and Social Services (the Department), Delaware Health Care Commission (the Division) and MedAllies, Inc. (the "Vendor"). The purpose of this second Amendment is to increase the executed amount of the contract by \$293,250.00 and extend the date of the contract through January 31, 2018 as it pertains to the Practice Transformation Services RFP - HSS-15-030.

WHEREAS, 19.1 of the Contract allows for an amendment when written consent of all parties to the Contract is obtained;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the following amendment shall be accomplished and incorporated in Contract (including the Contract effective November 9, 2016) as if fully set forth therein, as the parties do consent to amend the Contract as follows:

1. The Contractor will continue to perform the services outlined in the contract and services described in Appendix A and B of the original contract for HSS-15-030.
2. This amendment is to extend practice transformation services for a second year as outline in the original RFP HSS-15-030 and in accordance with the availability of year 3 federal grant funds from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMMI) Year 3 SIM Cooperative Agreement grant. Total payments under this second amendment shall not exceed \$293,250 for services ending January 31, 2018.
 - a. This amount is based on a set budget of \$12,750 per site per year inclusive of overhead and management costs.
 - b. Funding under this amendment allows for the following:

- i. **Current Practice Site Enrollment at the end of year one: 19**
- ii. **Amendment 2:**
 1. **MedAllies** will continue to provide services for the 19 practice sites currently enrolled during Wave 1/year one.
 2. **MedAllies** may recruit and enroll a maximum of 4 new practice sites in Wave 2/Year 2 of practice transformation services. If a Wave 1/Year 1 practice site dis-enrolls during the Year 2 contract period, **MedAllies** may enroll another site *only* with approval from the Health Care Commission.
 3. **MedAllies** will continue to provide qualitative and quantitative reporting as required in Wave 1/Year 1.
 4. Funding under this amendment will provide **MedAllies** with support for a *total* number of 23 enrolled practice sites for year two practice transformation services through January 31, 2018.
3. All other terms and conditions of the contract shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This amendment shall become effective upon signature of all parties.
