1. What if Breast and Cervical screening flow does not work with the number of people in the van?

Answer: We would suggest trying different approaches with the screenings to find one that works. If it still seems to be a problem, we can evaluate the number of people screened.

2. Can we link the BP/BMI requirement with outside health screening events we attend?

Answer: Yes

3. The guideline for mammograms is age 40. Can we screen younger women for paps?

Answer: Yes, we will go by the CDC age guidelines for pap screenings

4. What if we cannot do both mammography and pap screening with the allotted budget amount?

Answer: Respond to the RFP as proposed. Negotiations can occur during the contract process

5. The Scope of Services has increased from the current contract?
