Pre-Bid Meeting Questions

1. Do you anticipate only one (1) testing facility for the State of Delaware?

Answer: There are no immediate plans to increase the amount of Testing and Compliance Facilities (Testing Center). Due to the cost of starting and operating a Testing Center, one should be sufficient for some time. We will be looking closely at bidders who will be able to keep up with the forecasted demand.

2. Is there a particular location that the center needs to be in?

Answer: No, that is totally up to the bidder, the centers in all three counties will use the same center, so location is not a strong factor.

3. Will the testing center be responsible for picking up the items to be tested from the Compassion Centers?

Answer: That is one of the elements the Program will be looking at in the RFP, what are the vendor's plans for sample size, sample selection, receive the products from the Compassion Centers, how they will track the specimens, store the samples, and ultimately report on the samples.

4. How does the actual awarding of the testing center take place and what is the process?

Answer: It will follow the typical procurement selection process. The Medical Marijuana program will receive the bid proposals from the procurement section, a team of subject matter experts will read each proposal and grade it against the scoring criteria found in the RFP. The successful bidder will be selected in accordance the procedures stated in Section IV. B and C of this RFP.

5. How will the Testing Center be funded?

Answer: Each Compassion Center in the State will submit product for testing, the Testing Center will receive payment from the Compassion Centers on a per sample basis. The sampling plan and testing costs must be coordinated between the State, the Compassion Centers and the Testing Center.
