Question 1:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please describe the SNAP-Ed population.
Answer 1:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The SNAP-Ed target audience includes SNAP participants, low-income individuals eligible to receive benefits under SNAP or other means-tested Federal assistance programs, such as Medicaid or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, and individuals residing in communities with a significant (50 percent or greater) low-income population.
Question 2:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please explain Primary Prevention.
Answer 2:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> SNAP-Ed focuses on primary prevention and not on medical nutrition therapy. Medical nutrition therapy services are outside the scope of SNAP-Ed. Allowable SNAP-Ed activities focus on primary prevention of disease. Primary prevention projects include education, marketing, policy, systems, and environment interventions. Primary prevention activities help the SNAP-Ed population to prevent or to postpone the onset of chronic disease by establishing more physically active lifestyles and healthier eating habits.
