Question: It is not possible to report below the method specified detection limit since the lab cannot technically see anything below the limit of detection. Is this implying that the lab should lower the reporting limits compared to the federal limits for drinking water? –

*Answer:* What we meant by that is that the lab's method detection limit should be at or below the method specified detection limit.
