# ADDENDUM #1- QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR HSS-19-046 AmeriCorps Request for Applications 2019-2020

#### Q1: Is the process the same for applying for a planning grant in formula?

A1: Yes, this RFP pertains to operating AmeriCorps programs and planning grants.

On page 1 of Appendix C, Letter of Intent, Question 1: Brief Description of Program, indicate you are applying for a planning grant. On page 3 of Appendix C, in the AmeriCorps members section, check the Planning grant box.

# Q2: Are we able to edit what we already submitted for the competitive grant?

A2: Yes, if your competitive grant application in the Corporation for National and Community Service was not awarded, the application will be moved to the Formula grant application in eGrants. You can simply edit and submit. However, anything submitted in the federal eGrants system will not be reviewed or considered until the applicant has completed the RFP process.

#### Q3: Where is the RFP?

A3: The RFP is posted on-line on the Bid Solicitation Directory at: <a href="https://mymarketplace.delaware.gov/">https://mymarketplace.delaware.gov/</a>

## Q4: Is there anywhere to find an example of previous planning grant applications?

A4: This would require a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. The request should be submitted to the Procurement Office via email: <a href="mailto:DHSS">DHSS</a> <a href="mailto:DHSS">DMS</a> <a href="mailto:dmsprocure@delaware.gov">dmsprocure@delaware.gov</a>.

We cannot guarantee the request will be completed before the bids are due.

## Q5: When should we start following the bid site?

A5: For this current RFP, it is recommended you check the bids website at least weekly, to check for any changes in dates, addendums, etc.

The next AmeriCorps related RFP will be posted in November or December.
