NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS

1.0 GENERAL NOTES:

- 1.1 Bidders are hereby notified that this Addendum shall be and hereby becomes part of their Contract Documents, and shall be attached to the Project Manual for this project.
- 1.2 The following items are intended to revise and clarify the Drawings and Project Manual, and shall be included by the Bidder in their proposal.
- 1.3 Bidders shall verify that their Sub-bidders are in full receipt of the information contained herein.
- 1.4 All addenda will be sent out to the registered plan holders via email. Contractors are encouraged to keep an eye on their email accounts during the bidding periods for such updates. All interested parties are also encouraged to monitor www.mymarketplace.delaware.gov, where this project's cumulative solicitation documents are available for viewing.

1.5 SITE VISIT MEETING:

A site visit was held on Monday, August 13, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the Lake Forest School High School. The following items were reviewed:

- A. Project Description: A brief overview of the Project was discussed.
- B. Project Schedule: On site construction commencement, to begin ASAP.
- C. Bid schedule is as follows:
 - 1. The bids are due by Friday 2:00 p.m. on 17 August 2018.
 - 2. All questions **must** be submitted **in writing** (via <u>email</u>, <u>fax or mail</u>) to R G Architects. Neither R G Architects, its consultants, nor the Owner will answer questions verbally. **No questions should be submitted or will be answered after that date.**
 - 3. The last day for addenda to be issued shall be **Tuesday**, 14 August 2018.
- D. The project will be constructed using the State of Delaware Prevailing wage rates. The current rates are listed in the specification booklet.

E. Subcontractors List:

- 1. The subcontractors list noted on the bid form in the project manual was reviewed and agreed upon. No additional subcontractors were added during this time.
- 2. The General Contractor may NOT list more than one subcontractor for a discipline on the subcontractor's list.
- 3. On the Subcontractors List, the General Contractor must list the subcontractor that is providing the labor for 100% of the work in that category and as is required by the laws of Title 29.
- F. Drug Testing Policy: Drug Testing Policy in place by State of Delaware. Contractors are to reference the Project Manual for additional policy procedures and Drug Testing Report Forms.

4.0 QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

- Q.1. There are a couple of areas noted on the plans to be repaired. However, it was noted at the meeting that additional patching will be required. How should the bidders quantify the additional patching to ensure that everyone is bidding the same scope?
 - A. Refer to attached drawing A11-02 Enlarged Plans, this addendum, for areas of patching required.
- Q.2. Is there a provision for liquid asphalt adjustment in accordance with DelDOT specifications?
 - A. Yes, the cost of the asphalt materials shall be adjusted based on DelDOTS's monthly "Delaware Posted Asphalt Price."

- A. Coordination: Modify or adjust affected adjacent work as necessary to completely integrate work of the alternate into Project.
 - 1. Include as part of each alternate, miscellaneous devices, accessory objects, and similar items incidental to or required for a complete installation whether or not indicated as part of alternate.
- B. Notification: Immediately following award of the Contract, notify each party involved, in writing, of the status of each alternate. Indicate if alternates have been accepted, rejected, or deferred for later consideration. Include a complete description of negotiated modifications to alternates.
- C. Execute accepted alternates under the same conditions as other work of the Contract.
- D. Schedule: A Schedule of Alternates is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in schedule contain requirements for materials necessary to achieve the work described under each alternate.




