Dear Mr. Sharma,

The provisions of Contract No. LPSP-01-2012 for Wastewater Treatment Plant at Lums Pond State Park provide that the terms of the contract may be renegotiated and extended by mutual consent. The Delaware Division of Parks and Recreation would like to exercise that option and extend the contract for a period of three (3) years. For the extension term, the Delaware Division of Parks and Recreation will adjust the Annual Contract Fee as follows:

2015 \$33,150.00

2016 \$33,150.00

2017 \$33,150.00

The increase in annual fee over the next three years reflects plant coverage costs that have risen due to increased grease concentration causing higher foaming and sludge, changes in weather resulting in higher pH conditions, and an increase in hours. All other contract terms and conditions apply.

The three (3) year extension term will be effective January 6, 2015 and will expire on January 5, 2018.

Please sign this letter indicating your acceptance and scan the letter back to me by December 16, 2014. An executed copy will be returned for your records.

In addition to this extension notice, we are requesting a current copy of your Certificate of Insurance. If you would please send the Certificate with this signed extension letter, we will update our audit records.
