

1. How many tons of mulch were hauled from the Polly Drummond yard waste site in the last three calendar years:

2010: 8,989 tons

2011: 2,970 tons

2012: 9,933 tons

2013 YTD: ~7,568 tons

Some of the mulch produced in 2011 was hauled away in 2012, accounting for the “small” 2011 and “large” 2012 numbers.

2. Is it possible to lease the Polly Drummond yard waste site from DNREC?

The DNREC Division of Parks and Recreation can't allow the land the site is on to be leased, because the purchase of the land involved Federal funds. This also keeps us from allowing a retail business at the site, or charging a fee for yard waste that is dropped off at the site.

3. What if we want to do something different than exactly what the RFP outlines?
