

## **SECTION 00 11 16 – INVITATION TO BID**

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Parks and Recreation, Office of Design and Development will receive sealed bids in the Auditorium, DNREC Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover Delaware 19901, until 3:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, May 14, 2015, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud for the following Project: Rocky Run Bridge Replacement, Brandywine Creek State Park, DNREC Project No. BC-12

Project involves the installation of a premanufactured steel pedestrian bridge and the construction of reinforced concrete abutments with stone cladding. The project will also include the construction of a 100 foot long gravel path.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 23, 2015, at 10:00 at the Brandywine Creek State Park parking lot, Thompson Bridge Road (Route 92), Wilmington, Delaware. **ATTENDANCE OF THIS MEETING IS A PREREQUISITE FOR ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS AND WILL BE A PREREQUISITE FOR SUBMITTING A BID.**

Prospective bidders may obtain bidding documents upon payment of \$25.00 for each set at the above address. Checks are to be made payable to Division of Parks and Recreation. This payment is non-refundable and the documents need not be returned.

Bidding documents will be available for review at the following locations: Division of Parks and Recreation; Delaware Contractors Association and Associated Builders and Contractors.

Bidders will not be subject to discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin in consideration of this award, and Minority Business Enterprises, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, Women-Owned Business Enterprises and Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids on this contract. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security equivalent to ten percent of the bid amount and all additive alternates. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
