**Contractor Secondary Prequalification
for
DNREC Contract No. 2016-WCCSP-100
White Clay Creek State Park
WCCSP Tri-Valley Trail**

The Division of Parks and Recreation, DNREC, will be receiving Supplemental Prequalification applications for **DNREC Contract No. 2016-WCCSP-100** in the Office of Preservation, Planning and Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, DNREC, Richardson and Rollins Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover, DE 19901 until **2:00 PM on September 1, 2016**. This project is anticipated to be advertised for bids in mid- September 2016.

Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management (OMB/DFM) Annual Prequalification is a prerequisite to submitting the Supplemental Prequalification. Applications for Annual Prequalification can be submitted to OMB/DFM concurrently when the Supplemental Prequalification is submitted to the Division of Parks and Recreation.

Project Scope:

DNREC, Division of Parks and Recreation, Delaware State Parks is extending the trail system in the White Clay Creek State Park in the area known as Tri-Valley. Mobilization is anticipated to start November 7, 2016. The improvements will consist of the following:

- The new asphalt trail will begin at Thompson Station Road, extend to and along Nine Foot Road and terminate at an existing parking lot on Nine Foot Road.
- A new asphalt trail will begin at a proposed parking lot off of Smith Mill Road and extend down Smith Mill Road eventually connecting with an existing trail
- Base bid includes the complete removal of an existing gravel lot.
- Alternate No. 1 includes paving an existing parking lot located on Nine Foot Road.
- Alternate No. 2 consists of a new parking lot off of Smith Mill Road. This alternate includes a new prefabricated, concrete restroom. New sidewalks, new sewer drain field, well installation, water connections, sewer connections and power connections are included as part of this alternate.

To prequalify as a contractor/subcontractor for this project, you must have completed five trail projects within the last five (5) years that is similar in size (approximately \$1,500,000 and 1.5 miles long) and complexity to this project.

As authorized by 29 Del. C. § 6962(c), in order to submit a bid on this project, contractors must be prequalified in the classification listed below on an Annual basis AND provide certified responses to the Supplemental Request for Information specific to this project. However, certain other conditions as they relate to Maximum Contract Dollar Value may apply. Please see the full text of the Prequalification Regulations at <http://dfm.delaware.gov/prequal/>.

Please note that all other subcontractor categories do not require prequalification in order to participate in the bidding process.

Contractors must submit applications for any required Annual Prequalification and responses to the Supplemental Request for Information for this project by **2:00 PM on September 1, 2016**. Only those contractors prequalified on an Annual basis and who have submitted certified responses to the Supplemental Request for Information will

be allowed to submit bids. Those Contractors with an up-to-date Annual prequalification need only submit their Supplemental Application and re-affirm that the responses to its most recent Annual Prequalification application remain true and accurate in all respects. DFM hereby provides notice that it intends to investigate and verify each contractor's responses as authorized by 29 Del. C. § 6962(c)(4). In addition to any other rights or remedies at law or equity, DFM reserves the right to deny prequalification or otherwise disqualify any vendor who fails to accurately and truthfully respond in its application or responses to the Supplemental Information Request. See 29 Del. C. § 6962(c)(6).

The final prequalified Contractor Registry for this project will be posted at <http://dfm.delaware.gov/prequal/> . Only those Contractors listed on the registry for this project will be permitted to submit a bid.

Minority Business Enterprises, Disadvantaged Business Enterprises, Women-Owned Business Enterprises and Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit prequalification on this contract and will not be subject to discrimination on the basis of race, creed, color, sexual orientation, gender identity or national origin.
