### **General Information:**

A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held May 2, 2017. The sign-in sheet is included with this Addendum.

### Pre-bid Meeting:

- Brief description of the scope of work: Restoration of an historic stone fountain that was previously dismantled.
  - A. The Fountain was dismantled in 2015 and the pieces that were salvageable were crated. A few pieces that were not salvageable were also crated so that a comparison can be made for the replicate pieces. A 3-D model was made of the mermaid section.
  - B. Removal of crates to the successful contractor's shop for restoration.
  - C. Replicate in cast stone pieces that were not salvageable. Restore pieces that were salvageable.
  - D. A conservator is needed to finely sculpt the replicate pieces.
  - E. Painting of interior of fountain basin.
  - F. Step restoration.
  - G. Plaza paver resetting.
- 2 The Alternates were discussed.
  - A. Alternate One: Step Restoration as shown on Sheet A-2.
  - B. Alternate Two: Provide laser scan and 3D model of the conserved columns.
  - C. Alternate Three: Delete the infill of the existing lighting cavities with concrete. Provide new waterproof, vandal proof light fixtures to replace the existing light fixtures.

- 3 Schedule: The work will begin once bids are received, contracts are let and a purchase order is issued. It is anticipated that the PO will be issued in mid-June.
- 4 No phasing is planned for this project.
- Work by Others: The State will be contracting with a plumber to reconnect the fountain to water and to determine the location of an underground leak. The successful contractor will need to coordinate the efforts of the plumber with the progress of the work so that as the Fountain is reconstructed, the water system can be installed.
- 6 Contract requirements were discussed.
  - A. State of Delaware Prevailing wages apply to this Work. Copies of the wage rates have been included in the Technical Manual.
  - B. Ten-percent security bond is required.
  - C. Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond are required.
    - 01. The forms provided in the Project Manual shall be used. Other forms will not be accepted.
  - D. The bid is to be submitted with one original and one copy provided.
  - E. The number of days to complete the base work as well as alternates shall be listed on the bid form.
  - F. Limits: Confine construction operations to the limits indicated on the drawings.
  - G. Owner Occupancy: The surrounding Park is open to the public. The site is to be secured when on-site work is taking place and after hours.
  - H. The surrounding site, buildings, sidewalks and roadways beyond the work area shall remain accessible to the Owner and general public.
  - I. Public Roadways, Driveways and Entrances: Keep public and private roadways, driveways and entrances serving the premises and adjacent park clear and available to Owner, Owner's employees, general public and emergency vehicles at all times. Do not use these areas for parking or storage of materials unless otherwise designated.
  - J. The Owner will not sign for any deliveries at any time.
  - K. The Contractor shall minimize conflicts and facilitate usage of areas and sites beyond the construction limits and property boundaries. Perform the Work so as not to interfere with owner's operations.
  - L. Dumpster and Contractor Parking: Contractor parking and dumpster can be located within a fenced area across from the Fountain. Dumpsters shall be covered to prevent windblown debris and have a sign stating "No Trespassing." It is recommended not to have a dumpster as it will be used by others.
  - M. Material storage will be allowed at the site. The Owner is not responsible for theft or vandalism.
  - N. Power: Power is available for use by the contractor.
  - O. Water: Water is available for use by the contractor.
  - P. The contractor's superintendent will be required to be on-site at all times when work is taking place. This shall include those times when the work is being done only by the subcontractors and not the General Contractor. The superintendent shall meet with DNREC's representative on a weekly basis to review the work schedule that may interfere with their operations or upcoming events at the Park. The superintendent must be able to communicate with the DNREC representative.
  - Q. Grounds must be kept clean at all times.
  - R. Hours of Operation: Work can be completed 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during Monday through Friday. Saturday / Sunday and after hours work must be coordinated and approved with the Owner's representative in advance.
  - S. The construction crews will not be allowed to use the Owner's telephones.
  - T. Public Restrooms: Portable units adjacent to the Fountain can be used during on-site activities.
  - U. Flammable materials shall be kept outside, away from all buildings, in a flammable liquid/material storage box.
  - V. Wilmington State Park is State property and therefore non-tobacco use areas. Tobacco shall not be

used in State buildings or on State property or in vehicles parked on State property.

- Anticipated start date of the Work is mid-June, 2017 upon submission of bonds, contract and insurances to the State of Delaware and the issuance of a State of Delaware purchase order.
- 8 The Bid Form was reviewed:
  - A. The following requested subcontractors to be listed on the Bid Form were reviewed and accepted by those present: Pavers, Masonry Restoration, Cast Stone Replication and Crane Operator.
  - B. Each subcontractor is to be identified, even if the work is to be completed by the submitting contractor.
  - C. The General Contractor and subcontractors shall be licensed in the State of Delaware or have applied for a Delaware license prior to the submission of the bid. A license for New Castle County and the City of Wilmington will be required.
- All questions shall be faxed or e-mailed to Cindy Todd, <u>cindy.todd@state.de.us</u> and Kevin Rychlicki, <u>kevin.rychlicki@state.de.us</u>. The last day for questions shall be Friday, May 12, 2017 at 12:00 PM. The last addendum will be issued no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, May 12, 2017.
- Bids are due Wednesday, May 24 at 3:00 PM. The bids will be opened in the DNREC auditorium located at 89 Kings Highway, Dover and read aloud. Bids received after 2:00 PM will not be accepted nor opened.
- All bidders must review both the technical manual and drawings as they are complimentary. Electronic copies of the files can be purchased from DNREC for a cost of \$25.00 per disc.
- Permits are not required for this Project.
- 13 The prebid meeting attendance and purchase of the CD is mandatory for contractors submitting a bid.
- An arts festival is held in the Park the first Saturday after Labor Day. Set up begins the Friday before The State requested that no construction activities occur on those days.

Therefore, no public construction contract in this State shall be bid on, awarded to, or received by contractors and individuals on this list for a period of (3) three years from the date of the judgment or as deemed by a court of competent jurisdiction.
