The Special Provisions of Contract NAT17-001-TROUT, Trout Stocking Program provide that the term of the contract may be extended by mutual consent. The Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC), Division of Fish & Wildlife would like to exercise that option and extend the contract with Zion Grove Trout Hatchery for a period of one year under the same terms, costs and conditions. Specifically, you were awarded: spring pond stockings of Rainbow Trout (1,250 lbs of 12-13" fish), spring stream stockings of Rainbow Trout (13,350 lbs of 12- 13" fish), spring stream stocking of Brown Trout (2,200 lbs of 11-12" fish), spring stream & pond stockings of trophy Rainbow or Brown Trout (1,096 lbs of minimum 14" fish), and the fall stream stocking of Rainbow Trout (1,000 lbs of 12-13" fish).
