The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Fish & Wildlife will receive sealed bids in the Auditorium, DNREC Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover Delaware 19901, until 2:00 p.m. local time on October 23, 2019, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Auditorium. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bid received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves resurfacing of a deteriorating parking area, pavement removal, grading, and creation of open space areas.

A **MANDATORY** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 10:00AM on October 2, 2019 at the Bowers Beach Parking Area project site (see meeting location map on [www.bids.delaware.gov](http://www.bids.delaware.gov)) for the purpose of establishing the listing of subcontractors and to answer questions. Contractors arriving after 10:00AM will not be considered eligible for bidding. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security equivalent to ten percent of the bid amount and all additive alternates. The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days' notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
