

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Technical Manual:

- 1 Refer to Section 133200, Pole Building Systems
  - A. Overhead doors shall minimally be the following: Commercial grade, insulated, 24-gauge steel sections that are 2-inches thick, hot dipped galvanized with a baked polyester finish. Stiles are box-shaped and galvanized and face-riveted. Section joints are tongue-and-groove. Tracks (2") bracket mounted. Torsion springs are helically wound with stress relieved, oil-tempered wire. Springs are individually calibrated for each door. Counter-balance torsion shafts are galvanized for rust resistance. Provide 2x12 SYP carriers at each side of posts for overhead doors.
  - B. Man doors shall minimally be the following: Galvanized, 2-inch hollow metal frames. Doors shall be heavy wall FRP fiberglass faced 1 3/4"-inch thick doors as manufactured by Architectural Doors, Inc. (Model FD25) or equal. Doors shall have a 2-1/2" internal sub-main frame. Durable long lasting pebbled embossed FRP door face sheets. Door constructed to meet heavy duty usage. Built in 1/8" thick x 6" tubular closer reinforcing. Extruded Tubular Aluminum Sub-Framing System. Built in strength using true mortise and tenon corner joints. 3/8" steel tie-rods run the full width of header thru a secure spline assembly.
