All interested parties;

As you may be aware on Friday March 13, 2020 Governor Carney declared a State of Emergency due to the public health threat of COVID-19 and issued a proclamation authorizing all public meetings of executive branches to be conducted electronically, either telephonically or via video-conference. Out of an abundance of caution, the Department is changing the public bid opening process to the following format:

- Bid application are still due Monday, June 1, 2020.

- Bid applications may be dropped to the State Street Commons Office prior to 4:00 P.M. local time on Monday, June 1, 2020.
- Please make sure **your** name and return address are clearly listed on the outer envelope.
- People who drop-off bids are not permitted to remain in the building.
- There will be no in-person meeting for the opening of the bids.
- Instead, the public opening will be conducted telephonically.
- Bids will be opened immediately after 4:00 P.M
- Members of the public and interested parties may call in to hear the bid opening and the reading of the bids No one will be permitted to dial in from the building.
