

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for Contract No. NAT201502/TED.HARVEY, will be received by the State of Delaware, Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Fish and Wildlife, at the Richardson & Robbins Building, 89 Kings Highway, Dover, Delaware 19901 until 2:00 p.m. local time on May 11, 2016, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Auditorium. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves performing earthwork to raise the elevation of the existing levee and installation of new Water Control Structures within the levee at two locations to improve management of the water elevations within the Conservation Area.

Sealed bids shall be addressed to the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) Division of Fish and Wildlife, 89 Kings Highway, Dover, Delaware 19901, ATTN: Mr. Jeremy Ashe. The outer envelope should clearly indicate: **"DNREC CONTRACT NO. NAT201502/TED.HARVEY- SEALED BID - DO NOT OPEN."**

The successful bidder must post a performance bond and payment bond in a sum equal to 100 percent of the contract price upon execution of the contract. The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein. The Owner may extend the time and place for the opening of the bids from that described in the advertisement, with not less than two calendar days notice by certified delivery, facsimile machine or other electronic means to those bidders receiving plans.
