Dear Mr. Montgomery:

Based on the recommendation of the Proposal Review Committee on March 18, 2016, the State Employee Benefits Committee voted in favor of awarding the Cost Control and Program Integrity Review contract to Claim Technologies Incorporated for the medical claims audit and your subcontractor, Tricast, for the prescription claims audit for an initial term of six months or until the scope of work is performed to the State’s satisfaction.

The award is subject to negotiation of the performance guarantees, a finalized contract, and be contingent upon fulfillment of the Technology Terms and Conditions as required by DTI. At the State’s discretion, the contract may be extended for up to five (5) years with a guarantee of a 1.5% rate cap for each year.

We will begin working promptly with your team on the implementation of the terms in the RFP and the draft of the new contract.
