ADDENDUM #2

Following is a list of questions and responses related to the OMB Cost Control Solicitation.

1. On page 4, the RFP indicates that the review would encompass benefits for approximately 66,000 active employees and pensioners, but on page 5, the RFP lists active employees, retirees, and non-State employees, totaling 74,700. Will the review include 74,700 employees and pensioners, or 66,000?

Answer (A): The review will include all 74,700 employees and pensioners.

2. On page 7 in the Clinical Review section, the first bullet refers to “employer sponsored programs” – what, specifically, are those programs?

A: These reference the programs included in the Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield Delaware Agreement and the Aetna Agreement. The Highmark program includes the ProgenyHealth Neo-Natal Care Program, the Juvenile Diabetes Case Management Program and the Collaborative Care Management Activities with Alere. The Aetna program includes the Aetna Health Connections Services (Utilization Review, Case Management and other diseases specific programs.)

3. On page 7 in the Clinical Review section, the second bullet refers to a “vendor partner” – who is this vendor partner?

A: The vendor partners refer to Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield Delaware and Aetna. We are not asking for a review of Alere.

4. On page 7 in the Clinical Review section, the third bullet refers to “guaranteed program outcomes” – how are these outcomes defined?

A: Does not apply and does not need to be addressed by the proposing vendor

5. On page 7 in the Clinical Review section, the fourth bullet addresses a vendor “successfully” reaching members and achieving “successful” program participation – how is “success” measured?

A: Does not apply and does not need to be addressed by the proposing vendor

6. What is the budget for the Cost Control RFP?

A: Currently, there is no established budget for this RFP.

All other terms and conditions remain the same.
