The scope of work for this project includes master planning services for various State facilities located in New Castle County. The following sites include:

- Emily Bissell Hospital Campus located on Newport Gap Pike in Wilmington, Delaware
- Governor Bacon Center located on Route 9 in Delaware City, Delaware (selected OMB buildings)

The selected team will be required to provide specific services including, but not limited to: urban planning, including evaluation of demographic trends, use of State planning guidelines, local zoning rules and site environmental impacts; architectural, including space planning, programming, re-use of existing structures/spaces, and preliminary design, civil engineering including knowledge of sites, utilities (condition and availability), and stormwater regulations; along with other building engineering trades related to buildings located on the sites such as electrical, structural, mechanical, plumbing, fire suppression, or a required combination thereof. The goal of the plan is to provide the State an implementation plan that maximizes existing State-owned land and building assets, saving leased space costs to support State agency operations and deliver services to the public. A thorough knowledge of local and State codes including the New Castle County planning regulations is required. Initial study will consist of those sites listed above; additional services will be defined as required and may include other facilities and sites throughout the State.

- * defined approach firm/team will implement to complete this project (include team member specifics on previous projects of a similar nature)
- * knowledge of sites and project requirement (similar work in local area)
- * geographical location of main or branch office that will be assigned the project
- * familiarity with public works (including work for the State of Delaware, the <u>Delaware</u> <u>Code</u>, State agency regulatory review procedures and other local requirements,)
- * fees received by the firm for State of Delaware public works projects in the last five years (include breakdown)
