Sealed bids for **OMB/DFM Contract No. MC1002000378 – Carvel State Office Building – 12th Floor Core Heat Pump Replacement – Re-Bid** will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, in the reception area of the Facilities Management Office in the Thomas Collins Building, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1 (3rd Floor), Dover, DE 19901 until 1:00 p.m. local time on Monday, February 19, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

The project involves the replacement of heat pumps with a VAV system at the Carvel State Office Building in Wilmington, Delaware.
