Sealed bids for **OMB/DFM Contract No. MC2006000146 – New Castle Academy – Roof Replacement – Re-Bid** will be received by the State of Delaware, Office of Management and Budget, Division of Facilities Management, at the Thomas Collins Building, 540 S. DuPont Highway, Suite 1 (Third Floor), Dover, DE 19901 until 11:30 a.m.local time on Thursday, February 22, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidder bears the risk of late delivery. Any bids received after the stated time will be returned unopened.

Project involves roof replacement of the New Castle Academy Building located in New Castle, Delaware.

As authorized by 29 Del.
